

Hello CA Members

We are so grateful for all of you, our incredible members who have joined us in our commitment to provide a community that works together to prepare a place for children to move freely, exercise and have incredible interactions to enhance their lives. We are also grateful that the governor's update did not require changes or any added restrictions to our Phase III Operation Status.

CA has been and will continue to be committed to the highest level of vigilance with our students and staff when it comes to COVID-19 mitigation. We are adding to the current list of protocols to increase our risk prevention during the current health crisis effective immediately through January 17th, 2021.

First, we are requiring that all gymnastics class students 5 and older wear masks at all times while in the gym.

Please consider the following in relation to mask usage:

- 1 - Be sure to follow all CDC, VDH & Fairfax/Loudoun County mask guidelines.
- 2 - Student's 5 years and older should have a clean, comfortable and well fitted 3 layer mask.
- 3 - We ask you to review this with your child and help us make sure masks are worn from the time they pull up in the Drop Off Line, during entry, class time and until they exit from the gym in the Pick Up Line.
- 4 - Please notify CA if your child has any respiratory conditions which may prevent them from wearing a mask. We support the most safe and healthy situation for each child.

Second, any members who have planned travel or planned gatherings including people outside of your household members must be quarantined for 14 days from the day you return from travel or a restricted gathering.
